A late fee of \$40.00 will be assessed if tuition is not received by the 1st of the month and each month thereafter until paid.

All tuition, fees, cafeteria bills and fines owed must be paid and current on/before the following dates:

- July 31, 2009 for 12 month contracts
- October 30, 2009
- Start of 2nd Semester
- March 5, 2010
- May 3, 2010

Any family (student(s) from a family) not current on these dates will not be allowed to return to school until the past owed debt is paid and current. **Transcripts and student records will not be released until past due debt and contract obligations have been paid. For Seniors, all tuition, fees and fines owed must be paid before a student may receive a diploma and before transcripts or records can be released.**

It is further understood and agreed by me that I/we waive presentment, demand, protest and notice of dishonor and hereby agree to remain bound for payment of this contract notwithstanding any extension or extensions of time payment of it, or any part of it made by agreement with any or more parties hereto, and agree to pay all expenses incurred in collecting the same, including a reasonable attorney's fee of not less than 15% of the default balance with declared due and payable provided herein.

Section III. - Discipline/Dismissal

Corporal punishment (paddling) is one form of discipline that may be utilized by Central Academy. Please mark one of the following:

**If corporal disciplinary action is deemed necessary and you have selected – DO NOT PADDLE MY CHILD, the student(s) will be suspended for 2 days. Makeup work will be granted for class work.

It is agreed that Central Academy shall have the right to suspend or expel any student who violates the policies, rules or regulations of Central Academy whether now in existence or hereafter adopted. Central Academy reserves the right to terminate any education contract. Parents will be notified if a student is suspended or expelled. If disciplinary action results in the expulsion of a student, the remaining financial portion of the contract is due and payable. Until all financial obligations are met, transcripts and student records will not be released by the school.

Section IV. – Concession and Work Requirements

Parents are required to work one or more nights in the concession stand and other fundraising activities as scheduled. Failure to show up and work will result in a \$50.00 fine per incident.

Section V. Raffle –

A raffle payment of \$300.00 for the first child and \$100.00 for each additional child is due one day prior to the drawing. All tickets must be sold or PAID IN FULL before the drawing. Tickets cannot be added to your tuition. If the tickets are not sold or bought by the patron, the patrons name will not go on the unpaid tickets and be put into the drawing. Only the number of tickets paid at the time of the drawing will be entered into the drawing. **PATRONS WILL HAVE UNTIL THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL IN JANUARY TO PAY THE BALANCE DUE OF ANY UNSOLD TICKETS. THIS AMOUNT MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO THE SECOND SEMESTER IN ORDER FOR THE CHILD / CHILDREN TO RETURN TO SCHOOL.** Patrons registering after the raffle drawing will have the amount added to their contract, this amount will be payable in three (3) monthly installments.

Section VI. – Drug Test Policy

All students attending grades 7- 12 are subject to random drug test(s) after being enrolled in Central Academy.

Section VII. – Mississippi Private School Association

Central Academy is a proud member of the MPSA. Any person who causes problems at Central Academy or any Central Academy academic or athletic event that results in a fine(s) toward Central Academy from the MPSA will be required to pay the fines.

Section VIII. – Buyout Clause

For any student(s) withdrawing during the school year (for any reason except expulsion) or after executing a tuition contract, a \$1,000.00 buyout fee per student will apply. The parent or guardian shall be responsible for paying this fee.
